- 6) Member's at Large Report
 - A) Andres discussed the scholarship fund, which currently has about \$15,000 in it.
 - B) Andres handed out an information packet about ways to donate to the scholarship fund.
- 7) Undergraduate Chapter Report
 - A) We currently have 53 undergraduate members (51 initiates and 2 Ams)
 - B) The house GPA last semester was at the campus average (we had 8 4.0s)
 - C) We were 2nd in Barker points last year
 - D) The chapter recently hosted the LXA leadership impact 1 seminar for several members of our chapter and Brooklyn Poly.
 - E) We are planning a 5K run for charity during GM week.
 - F) The chapter won the Cole recruitment award at General Assembly as well as 3 other awards.
- 8) Elections
 - A) Doug Hancher was nominated for president and was elected by acclamation to a 2-year term as president.
 - B) Pete Reale was nominated for treasurer and was re-elected by acclamation to another 2-year term as treasurer.
 - C) Andres Gonzalez was nominated for Member at Large and was re-elected by acclamation to another 2-year term as Member at Large.
